

AS A SPA ENTHUSIAST, I've experienced a range of unusual treatments, from free-floating massage wraps to Reiki rain therapy to cayenne pepper facials. But as I watched the nail-care expert prepare for my recent mani-pedi at The Spa at Pelican Hill® by pulling on three sets of gloves—one on top of the other—I felt a slight wave of apprehension.

The Natura Bissé’s Diamond Experience facial is an ongoing favorite treatment on the Spa menu, using an energy-producing cocktail formulated with more than 30 active ingredients, including ATP and marine-originating DNA. The red-carpet-ready facial involves a rare three-step peel, a mixture that feels like champagne bubbles dancing on the skin and a botanical nectar serum that hydrates. The facial is so powerful that no extractions are needed (Who doesn’t love that?) and the aestheticians use a special lifting massage technique for anti-aging results. ☀
